Results from round 10 of the Illawarra Credit Union Rugby competition played on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2009.

In a high scoring match, Engadine continued their winning sequence with a 5 tries to 3 win over the injury weakened Shoalhaven. The final score was 31 points to 19. This left Engadine clear in third place on the table with 32 points.

The improved Shamrocks and Tech/Waratahs clashed in a cliff-hanger at Ocean Park Woonona. The first half was scoreless until just before half time when Richard Hoffman of Tech/Waratahs crossed for a try in the corner. This was not converted. At 5 points to nil at half time, it was anybodies match. The second half continued as the first with Tech/Waratahs having a glut of possession before Shamrocks leveled the score with a try in the corner to Steve Jones that was not converted. The match was a no holds barred affair before a charge down try to Peter Rowlings, converted by Scott Terasenko finally breaking the deadlock with 10 minutes to go. Tech/Waratahs continued to pressure the Shamrocks line for the final period and were finally rewarded with a converted try to

Tony Longbottom well into extra time resulting in a final score line of 12 points all. This lifts Tech/Waratahs to 38 points and Shamrocks to 18 points closing the gap on fifth placed University.

Second placed Avondale continued on their winning way with an 8 try to 1 rout of Vikings. The final score was 52 points to 5. Avondale are now comfortable in second place on the ladder with 35 points.

In the final game of the round, Kiama and Camden fought it out at Kiama Showground in a high scoring match. In the end, Kiama, scoring 4 tries to 3 came out 29 points to 24 points winners in a very close result. 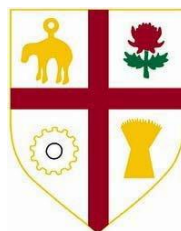
