Round 8 of the Illawarra Credit Union Rugby competition was held on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2009.

University and Shoalhaven clashed at Ricoh Rugby Park in what was expected to be the game of the round. It was a high scoring game with the visitors (Uni) scoring seven tries to three to run out winners 47 points to 19. The win lifted University to third on the 26 points, just 1 point behind Shoalhaven and 5 behind Tech/Waratahs.

Engadine continued on the winning run with a close 3 tries to 2 win over Kiama. It was an entertaining match with both sides showing commitment. The final score of Engadine 19 Kiama 12 ensured that Engadine maintained a clear fifth place in the competition on 23 points.

Shamrocks and Camden clashed at Ocean Park Woonona and both clubs are building new combinations based around bringing their juniors through the ranks. It was a free flowing game and Shamrocks went to half time leading 17 to 0 after two tries and a penalty. Camden needed to score early in the second half but were denied by scrambling defence from the young Shamrocks. A break by young representative winger John Millen lead to a try by Josh Woodford but Camden did not give in and were rewarded with a try to Andrew Black. The game ended in a 32 points to 5 win to Shamrocks.

In the final game of the round, Vikings hosted Tech/Waratahs. As expected, Tech/Waratahs came out fired up after their last minute loss to University in the last round and scored 8 tries to Vikings 2 tries with the final score line being 50 points to 17. This win takes Tech/Waratah to head of the competition on 31 points.

As we approach the halfway mark in the competition, there are only 8 points between the top five clubs and this could reduce further depending on results in next week's matches.
