The completion of the various competitions around the state has seen an increase in the number of applications from players wishing to play overseas.

The Australian Rugby Union has advised any players intending to play overseas must complete and lodge an "Application for Clearance to Play within another National Union" prior to their departure from Australia. It is the player's responsibility to lodge the application, not their Australian or Overseas Club.

The application must be completed in full, and must include the player's MyRugby Admin ID, name of the destination Home Union and Club, and must be signed by the respective player.

Effective immediately, the ARU will be updating the MyRugby Admin System with the movements of players leaving and entering Australia. Any inbound players playing in Australia for the first time will have a MyRugby Admin ID established, this ID will be advised to the player's club when the inbound clearance has been approved.

Please ensure this information, together with a copy of the Application for Clearance to Play in another National Union is advised/provided to your respective clubs.
